<u>Police & Fire</u> – 2015 Police budget is done. Dairyfest went fine with few incidents. National Night Out was a huge success. Fire Fighters blanket liability insurance has been referred to the Finance committee. 2015 Fire Department budget needs to be completed.

<u>Finance</u> – CDBG – nothing new to report. Saputo Water Supply Agreement – completed. Saputo waste water construction update – walls are up. Waste Water Agreement-new agreement needs to be completed. Village Attorney is currently working on it. Discussion followed. Deputy Clerk is working out well. Safe Drinking Water Loan –Closing is scheduled for end of October. Legal opinion of ownership is being worked on by Ayres Associates. Motion by Terry H. to authorize approval of the Waiver to WI DOA Regarding Taxable SDWL loan. Linda H. seconds motion. Motion carried. PSC Rate Application – has been received. 2015 budget – in progress. Construction payment request – Terry H. made a motion to open a Safe Drinking Water Loan account at First Merit Bank. Chad Misco seconds motion. Motion carried. Chad M. made a motion to pay from CDBG for \$51,186.36 and Safe Drinking Water Loan in the amount of \$141,786.21 totaling \$192,972.57 to Oudenhoven Construction Inc. Judy P. seconds the motion.
