To save on recycling costs to your municipality, please take your recyclables to your municipal drop-off center where you reside. Non-residents may be subject to additional charges to dispose of recyclables or not accepted at their drop off center.

The following municipalities manage the recycling for their citizens separately and are not affiliated with the Oconto County Recycling Program: Breed, Brazeau, Chase, Gillett (City & Town), Lakewood, Little River, City of Oconto, Pensaukee, Spruce, Townsend, and Underhill.

DROP OFF CENTERS- RESIDENTIAL WASTE STREAM ONLY!!

Please be aware that your municipal drop-off center is provided for the servicing of your citizens residential waste stream. Businesses are to provide for recycling as part of their business operations. Consult with your business waste hauler for proper business recycling options.



Do you have household hazardous waste that you are looking to dispose of properly? Oconto County along with Marinette County have applied for a Clean Sweep grant to assist in paying for the proper disposal of household hazardous waste or agricultural waste. This program is for the collection of waste generated within the geographical boundaries of Marinette and Oconto Counties. Many products you use in your home and yard contain hazardous materials. Improper disposal of these products can cause fires, injuries to people and animals and have the potential to contaminate groundwater. A Clean Sweep event, if approved, would be scheduled in the spring of 2019. Stay tuned for further information. Properly recycle electronics to protect citizens and the environment. Businesses, agencies and institutions are not included in the recycling program and are to manage their own waste.

High Intensity Discharge: (mercury vapor, metal halide, high pressure sodium)	\$1.50
Ballast: (must be removed from fixture)	\$7.00/item

Tire Recycling

All vehicle tires are accepted for disposal. Disposal cost is based on size of tire:

DISPOSAL COST (subject to change)

-17 inch or smaller	\$4.00
-18 to 22 inch	\$6.00
-Tire with rim	Double fee

Heavy ply tires may be accepted based on the following disposal cost (consult with attendant).

-Skid steer	\$40.00
-Tractor / Large Equipment Tire Sizes (ask Attendant)	cost varies \$60 - \$150
-Heavy Ply Tire with rim	Add \$40.00

If not accepted at the drop off center, **heavy ply tires** may be brought to the Oconto Co MRF. The disposal cost is based on weight of tire & the price/ton for disposal, currently \$265/ton.



Purchase a Compost Bin for \$35 and create your own garden compost. Composting is the natural decomposition of organic matter. Over one half of your household garbage is organic!



Mercury Thermostats are accepted free of charge at the Oconto County MRF. Broken thermostats are not accepted. Only wall mount thermostats with glass tube mercury switches are accepted. **Please recycle the entire thermostat.** For information on handling spills and cleanup search the EPA website www.epa.gov/hq/

Recycle plastic bags, film & wrap at participating locations such as grocery, retail & hardware stores. Oconto Co. MRF & drop off centers do not accept plastic bags, film or wrap. Loose plastic bags, film, rope, hoses, and clothing clogs up processing machinery causing unnecessary expenses at recycling facilities and at local landfill sites.

Recycling Facts:

- Americans will use over 2 and a half million plastic bottles every thirty minutes, and most of them are simply thrown away rather than recycled.
- Recycling one ton of plastic can save up to 1,000-2,000 gallons of gasoline.
- Glass recycling is separated into colors because glass retains its color even after recycling.
- Most people in America all use at least seven trees each year, through wood, paper and other types of products that use trees.
- One drip per second from a leaky faucet wastes 540 gallons of water a year.
