Public Works Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Chair Linda Hinds.

Roll call: Robert Borchert, Steve Marquardt and Linda Hinds.

Also present: Larry Shallow, Terry Earley and Charlene Meier.

Approval of agenda: Motion was made by Marquardt/L. Hinds to approve the agenda. Motion was voted and carried.

Public Comment: Clerk stated that a resident expressed concern for the recycling workers in the high temperatures with no air conditioning in their building. It was determined that it is not necessary.

Reported Complaints/Concerns Regarding Streets, Utility, if any: L. Hinds complained regarding the dust from the street where they installed a new lateral for 426 W. Maple Street and when the blacktop would be done. Shallow reported on the catch basin by Revolution's on W. Main Street.

Public Works Storage Building/Vehicle Replacement Update for Grant: USDA gave approval for \$95,000 for a new public works storage building/vehicle replacement. Specs are needed for the storage building so advertising can be done. Ayres will assist in drawing up specs for a 60' long x 40' deep, 14' high outside walls and to include electrical.

Sidewalk Review: Terry Earley provide numerous pictures of the sidewalks on Main Street showing the poor condition and where repairs will be needed. Earley will check with the Village Engineer regarding State standards for sidewalks. Also, he will check with Kelby Cook Construction for pricing. A suggestion was made to have flowerpots go around the light poles on Main Street. L. Hinds will check on this design.

Ordinance Review Water: Nothing was done on this ordinance.

Street Sweeper – Possibility: Informational only. Earley stated the condition is our current sweeper is not that good.

Wish List for American Rescue Monies: The following items were mentioned: sidewalk repairs, new pots, bobcat, village front parking lot.
