Motion was made by Hinds/Marquardt to pay the cost associated with the siren and installation with the line of credit from Fortifi Bank. Motion voted and carried. Clerk informed the committee that specs are needed for the public works building before we can bid it out.

<u>Update on Historical Society Checking account</u>: Clerk informed everyone that the Lena Historical Museum has a federal ID number. Marsha Kramer talked with the IRS and the IRS will re-activate that number. Discussion followed regarding 502 (3) (c) for the museum. Motion was made by Marquardt/Heise to recommend to the village board that the Village will cover the cost associated with becoming a 501 (3) (c) for the museum. Motion was voted and carried.
